

REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS
MECHANIC WORK AND MAINTNENANCE
OF CITY OF SUMMERVILLE
VEHICLE AND EQUIPMENT FLEET

The City of Summerville is requesting proposals for Mechanic Work and Maintenance of City Vehicles. The proposals should include a lump sum price schedule to paid by the City of Summerville on a quarterly basis. The proposer should consider the various vehicles and equipment to be serviced, such as backhoes, track hoes, trenchers, as well as dump trucks, regular sized trucks, police vehicles and fire engines.

The proposed start date of the agreement will be set by mutual agreement of both parties and is anticipated to begin July 1, 2017.

The City of Summerville reserves the right to withdraw the request for proposals at any time and for any reason and to issue a clarification, modification and/or amendment as it may deem appropriate. Proposal submissions shall be in writing and must include a signature and price schedule as set forth in the contract documents. Proposals shall be in a sealed envelope marked "City of Summerville Mechanic Work Proposal" and shall be received by mail or personal delivery on or before April 7, 2017 at 2:00 p.m. Attention Tony Carroll, City Manager, PO Box 180 Summerville, GA 30747. The City of Summerville has determined that it would be in the best interest of the City to award the contract for Mechanic Work and Maintenance of City Vehicles to the provider who uses the best technology and has a proven record with providing these services and has the ability to perform under the terms of the Request for Proposals. Therefore the lowest bidder may not receive the contract. All proposals, once received, shall become the property of the City of Summerville and will not be returned.
