

**JOB ANNOUNCEMENT
WASTE WATER TREATMENT PLANT
OPERATOR-TRAINEE**

The City of Summerville is accepting applications for a FULL-TIME WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT OPERATOR-TRAINEE.

Minimum Requirements: Applicant must have a standard High School Diploma or its equivalent. Must possess and maintain a valid Georgia driver's license, pass a pre-employment drug screen and background check. A Georgia Class III license must be obtained within three to five (3-5) months; such licenses should be maintained for the duration of employment. Salary will be based on qualifications and experience.

Essential Functions: Works under the supervision of the Plant Superintendent, Assists in monitoring and adjusting the processing system to meet demand; assists in inspecting plant grounds, checking gauges, and taking readings; assists in monitoring flow levels, pumps, motors and valves. Assists in monitoring overall plant operations via the Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) system. Assists in taking samples and testing chemical levels throughout the plant on a regular basis. Assists in adjusting chemical feeders as needed. Assists in monitoring flow throughout the plant to ensure proper operation. Assists in making equipment repairs and responds to breakdowns. Assists in maintaining log books and computer files containing laboratory analysis results, distribution system changes, filter backwash readings, process control changes, chemical inventory, and other pertinent information; documents all problems or complaints. Attends job-related training; remains current on revisions to pertinent policies, procedures, rules, regulations, requirements and standards. Performs related duties.

Physical Requirements: Must be capable of working outdoors with considerable walking, standing on concrete floors, climbing stairways and ladders with ease and able to climb down into wet wells or other confined spaces when wearing self-contained breathing apparatus. Must be capable of occasionally lifting and carrying an unassisted load of 40 pounds and regularly carrying tools or other equipment weighing at least 10 pounds.
