JOB SUMMARY

This position performs technical duties in the installation, repair, and maintenance of gas lines and system components.

MAJOR DUTIES

- Locates and repairs gas leaks.
- Responds to emergency repair calls, including after hours emergencies.
- Conducts gas inspections.
- Maintains odorizer levels.
- Turns gas service on and off.
- Installs, repairs, and maintains gas pipelines and meters.
- Locates underground utilities and marks location with paint.
- Reads and re-checks meters.
- Completes service reports.
- Paints meter sets and stations.
- Performs other related duties as assigned.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS/ WORK ENVIRONMENT

- The work is typically performed while intermittently sitting, standing, stooping, walking, bending, or crouching. The employee frequently lifts light and heavy objects, uses tools or equipment requiring a high degree of dexterity, climbs ladders, and distinguishes between shades of color.
- The work is typically performed outdoors. The employee may be exposed to noise, dust, dirt, grease, machinery with moving parts, irritating chemicals, and occasional cold or inclement weather.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- Associate's degree or equivalent experience.
- Sufficient experience to understand the basic principles relevant to the major duties of the position, usually associated with the completion of an apprenticeship/internship or having had a similar position for one to two years.
- Possession of or ability to readily obtain a valid driver's licenses issued by the State of Georgia for the type of vehicle or equipment operated.
